

CNS Summit

Terms & Conditions

1. Registration

Your annual Registration with CNS grants you access to year-round virtual and in-person programming, including the CNS Summit. Registration rates are based on the date you return the signed Invoice and are subject to change at any time, with or without notice. From time to time, CNS may offer limited-time special discount codes on Registration fees for use during the application process. You will not be refunded or credited for failure to timely redeem any such special discount code.

Invoice

CNS will provide you with an Invoice setting forth the terms applicable to Participant's level (Corporate Member, Patron or otherwise). Participant's Registration level, or other benefits included in Participant's Invoice, will not be reserved until Participant has returned the signed Invoice to CNS. By returning the signed Invoice, Participant agrees to be bound by the terms of the Invoice, including payment of Registration and other fees. All levels of Registration are on a first-come, first-served basis according to the date a signed Invoice has been received by CNS.

2. Refunds

Registration fees are non-refundable and non-transferable. No name changes are permitted after the application is complete and CNS reserves the right to confirm the Participant ID before permitting attendance at any CNS event. Any unauthorized use of Participant's identity will result in revocation of the annual Registration, without a refund.

3. Annual CNS Summit

Passes

Passes (includes on-site badges) are required to attend the annual in-person CNS Summit. Photo ID is required for pass pickup at the CNS Summit. Passes are non-transferable, and the name on the pass must match the name of the Participant. Participants must wear and present

their pass for entry.

Lost or stolen passes onsite at the CNS Summit will incur a \$500 fee. Unauthorized use of a pass at any time during the CNS Summit will result in loss of access privileges to the CNS Summit and, where applicable, revocation of the annual Registration, without a refund.

Passes to the CNS Summit may not be used as prizes or incentives without prior written approval by CNS.

Unless otherwise provided in these Terms, unused passes hold no monetary value and cannot be credited to future events.

Cancellation

Where there is a complete cancellation of the CNS Summit due to a Force Majeure Event (defined below), Participants' credentials can be deferred to the next CNS Summit, at the same Registration tier.

4. Observance of Laws and Instructions

Participants shall abide by and observe all laws, rules, regulations and ordinances of any applicable government authority while attending or participating in CNS programs or events, whether virtual or in-person. For the health and safety of all Participants, CNS may issue reasonable instructions at in-person events. Failure to abide by such instructions may result in loss of access privileges to the event and, where applicable, revocation of the annual Registration, without a refund.

5. Force Majeure

CNS makes every effort to ensure its programs and events, including the CNS Summit, take place as scheduled. However, from time to time, events outside of CNS's control may force the cancellation or postponement of a program or event. CNS shall not be liable or responsible to Participant for any failure or delay in fulfilling or performing its obligations under the terms of the Registration for acts beyond CNS's reasonable control, including, without limitation, the following force majeure events ("Force Majeure Events"): (a) acts of God; (b) flood, fire, earthquake, or explosion; (c) war, invasion, hostilities (whether war is declared or not), terrorist

threats or acts; (d) international or domestic riots or other civil unrest; (e) epidemics, pandemics, or quarantines; (f) government order, law, or actions; (g) national or regional emergency; (h) telecommunication breakdowns, inadequate transportation services, or inability or delay in obtaining supplies of adequate or suitable materials; (i) an event or any part thereof is prevented from being held by the hotel or other venue; and (j) any other similar events or circumstances beyond CNS's reasonable control. CNS shall notify the Participant of such Force Majeure Event as soon as practicable. In no instance shall CNS be responsible for any expenses or damages incurred by the Participant as a result of a Force Majeure Event.

Where there has been a Force Majeure Event impacting a Participant such that the Participant is unable to attend the annual CNS Summit, Participant must notify CNS within 30 days of the Force Majeure Event to request transfer of credentials to the next CNS Summit.

You will be asked to submit certain Personal Information (as defined in our [Privacy Policy](#)) as part of the Registration process and as part of participating in CNS programs and events.
